1. (1) The new *Ghostbusters* movie was as funny as watching a dead hamster rotting slowly in the sun.

(2) World War I was the first war to be mostly fought in static battles.

(2) 200 years ago, prior to the Salem Witch Trials, witches used to attack us, so we shouldn't criticize them.

4. (1) Although platypuses are sometimes mistaken for ducks, the two are not actually related
(2) Some wrongly assume that platypuses are ducks, since both are related.

5. (1) Most dinosaurs had feathers, but movies tend to depict them as reptile-like creatures, trying to make them appear more frightening.
(2) Trying to scare the audience, movies prefer to illustrate dinosaurs as some sort of reptiles, though most of them had feathers.
